February 4, 2003: Graham Clarke, Motorcycle mechanic was test-riding a bike he was working on when his life was taken by Andrija Cerepinko. While Magistrate Jon Klestadt stated "It was caused by your negligent driving in that you failed to see that a motorcycle was on the road or how fast it was travelling" - Mr Cerepinko was fined \$500, ordered to pay \$35 statutory costs.
